The Parent Survey of June 2017 provides evidence of the excellent relationships and trust that the school has built with parents. 100% of children are happy to come to school and 100% of parents feel that their children are taught well. All parents feel their child is well looked after and would recommend the school to other parents. This is further evidenced by the school's growing numbers.

Areas for Development

- One parent expressed concern over supervision when children arrive on buses. As a result, bus children will be met outside by Miss Walker and brought straight into school to take part in activities before classroom doors open.
- Two parents said that they would like teachers to hear their child reading more often. The school clarifies guided reading arrangements in a letter to parents and invited them to come and see how reading sessions work in order to show how children are listened to as part of the group session.
